**ADDENDUM**  
**OFFICIAL GAME RULES**  
**POWERBALL GAME RULES**  
**DOUBLE PLAY**

The following rules have been adopted by the New Jersey State Lottery Commission pursuant to the authorization contained in N.J.S.A. 5:9-7 as an addendum to the rules governing the POWERBALL Game to govern the operation of the “Double Play” feature.

Unless otherwise defined or the context clearly indicates otherwise, all capitalized terms used in this Addendum shall have the same meaning as defined in the Official POWERBALL Game Rules. The Double Play feature will be administered under the POWERBALL Game Rules except as herein provided. The additional rules are as follows:

**1. DEFINITIONS**

**Double Play** - means a game feature that gives players the opportunity for an additional chance to win a separate set of prizes from a separate Prize Fund. For an additional \$1.00, the Lottery draws a second set of numbers, giving the player a second chance of winning with the same numbers played in the base POWERBALL Play for a separate set of prizes.

**Double Play Drawing** - means the formal draw event for randomly selecting the winning indicia that determine the number of winners for each prize level of the Double Play game.

**Double Play First Prize** – means the guaranteed prize amount of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) for a Winning Play matching all five (5) of Matrix A plus one (1) of Matrix B. The First Prize payout shall be determined on a pari-mutuel basis.

**Double Play Winning Numbers** – means the game results selected during a Double Play Drawing which shall be used to determine winning Plays contained on game ticket or ticketless transaction.

**2. GAME PLAY**

- a. The Double Play option may be purchased for an additional \$1.00, per play, or multiples thereof in the case of a Multi-Draw Wager, at the discretion of the Purchaser.

### 3. DRAWINGS

- a. The Double Play Winning Numbers are drawn from the same Matrix used for each POWERBALL Drawing. A random Double Play drawing will occur after every POWERBALL Drawing to determine the Double Play Winning Numbers.

### 4. PRIZE STRUCTURE

- a. The expected Prize Pool for each Double Play drawing is approximately fifty-five percent (55%) of the money wagered by all players, plus the carryover amount, if any. The Prize Pools are generated from the Double Play prize fund. Double Play Prizes are as indicated in the grid below:

- b. All Double Play Prizes, including the Double Play First Prize, shall be paid in one (1) payment.
- c. The Double Play First Prize of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) dollars is guaranteed if a Player has a Winning Ticket. The Double Play First Prize payout shall be determined on a Pari-Mutuel basis. A Double Play First Prize payout shall be divided equally among the number of First Prize Winning Tickets. The Double Play First Prize shall be fixed at a non-annuitized value of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) for every drawing. If in any Double Play drawing in which no Double Play Wager(s) qualify for the Double Play First Prize, the Double Play First Prize will remain fixed at the non-annuitized value of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) for the subsequent drawings.

### 5. RETAILER REQUIREMENTS, COMMISSIONS AND BONUSES

- a. The Retailer(s) selling a winning 5 out of 69 + 1 out of 26 Double Play First Prize Winning Ticket shall receive a \$25,000.00 bonus from the Lottery. The Agent(s) selling a winning 5 out of 69 Double Play Winning Ticket shall receive a \$2,500.00 bonus from the Lottery.
